Regarding the article type, Review, Article, Communication, *etc* are acceptable. Microorganisms has no restrictions on the length of manuscripts, provides that the text is concise and comprehensive. Microorganisms is an **open-access journal**, and is free for readers, with the article processing charges (APC) of 1200 CHF in 2019 (1600 CHF in 2020) paid by authors or their institutions (<https://www.mdpi.com/journal/Microorganisms/apc>), no matter how many pages your papers have. Being suggested papers by me and on the scope of COST Action SOURDOMICS (CA18101), you will be charged **600 CHF** (*ca.* 547€) (papers submitted in 2019) or **800 CHF** (*ca.* 729€) (paper submitted in 2020), thus getting a **50% discount**.

Microorganisms had been indexed by Scopus in July this year (<https://www.mdpi.com/journal/microorganisms/indexing>), but it will take 4-6 months to upload the database of the journal to Scopus website. They can research the related information on quartile in *Scimago within the next few months*. Also we will make you informed of the latest updates on the quartile in Scimago..
